Learn more about the Yukon's fascinating bird life with the Yukon Bird Club. Field trips are guided by skilled and enthusiastic birders and explore some of the Yukon's best birding areas.

Over 200 species of birds have been observed on YBC field trips including local specialties such as Trumpeter Swan, Eurasian Wigeon, Red-necked Phalarope, Peregrine Falcon, Golden Eagle, Willow Ptarmigan, Parasitic Jaeger, Thayer's Gull, Boreal Owl, Northern Hawk Owl, Three-toed Woodpecker, Mountain Chickadee, Hammond's Flycatcher, Brewer's Sparrow, and Gray-crowned Rosy Finch.

The Yukon Bird Club's regular publication, ***Yukon Warbler*** highlights club events, bird sightings, identification tips and biodiversity research projects. The winter seminar series brings images of bird life to the Yukon even when daylight is short and temperatures cold.
